SECTION I — CITATION OF UNIT

The 142d Infantry Regiment, for exceptional performance from 26 May to 26 June 1944 in the monumental 29-day push from the Anzio beachhead area through Rome to the hills overlooking Pisa. Although a sudden change of plans prevented preliminary reconnaissance, the 142d Infantry Regiment launched a coordinated attack against Mount Artemisio, located behind the enemy stronghold of Velletri, seized the mountain and defended it against savage counterattacks. The regiment pressed irresistibly forward, driving the demoralized enemy before it and marched through Rome on 5 June. As these relentless troops swept north of Rome, the enemy attempted, at various places of advantage, to turn and meet them, but every new counterattack was foiled and the 240 mile advance was concluded on the high ground commanding the approaches to Pisa. The determination and accomplishments of the 142d Infantry Regiment were a vital factor in delivering the most crushing blow suffered by the enemy forces in Italy.

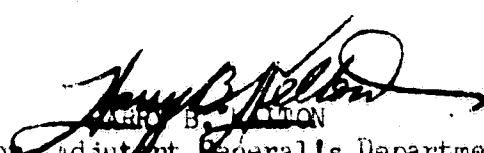
