The members of the tunk crew were unaware of the danger until these men signalled for the driver to stop the vehicle. They climbed onto the tank and, in spite of the intense heat of the blaze and the imminent danger of the amounition exploding, began to fight the fire with extinguishers handed them by personnel on the ground. Only after using several extinguishers and making repeated attacapts to cut the net loose from the tank were they able to push the flaming moterial onto the ground and there smother the fire. By their quick-thinking and iggs ssiveness; these men prevented casualties and saved a valuable piece of government equipment from destruction.
