I. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL. Under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, as amended, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded to the following named individual for meritorious service in combat operations:

JOHN J. ALBRIGHT, 07305, Colonel, General Staff Corps, Chief of Staff, 36th Infantry Division, 15 to 25 March 1945, France and Germany. Entered the Service from Lisbon, Ohio.

II. AWARD OF OAK LEAF CLUSTER - BRONZE STAR MEDAL. 1. Under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, as amended, an Oak Leaf Cluster in lieu of a second Bronze Star Medal is awarded to each of the following named individuals for meritorious service in combat operations:

WALTER W. HLSS, JR., 03850, Brigadier General, U. S. Army, Commanding 36th Infantry Division Artillery, 15 to 25 March 1945, France and Germany. Entered the United States Military Academy from Pennsylvania.

CHARLES H. OWENS, 06957, Colonel, Commanding 141st Infantry Regiment, 15 to 25 March 1945, France and Germany. Entered the Service from Boise, Idaho.

CHARLES J. DENHOLM, 021293, Lieutenant Colonel, Commanding 143d Infantry Regiment, 15 to 25 March 1945, France and Germany. Entered the United States Military Academy from Pennsylvania.

2. Under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, as amended, a second Oak Leaf Cluster in lieu of a third Bronze Star Medal is awarded to the following named individuals for meritorious service in combat operations:

ROBERT I. STACK, 07585, Brigadier General, U. S. Army, Assistant Division Commander, 15 to 25 March 1945, France and Germany. Entered the Service from New York.

GEORGE E. LYNCH, 017715, Colonel, Commanding 142d Infantry Regiment, 15 to 25 March 1945, France and Germany. Entered the United States Military Academy from the United States at Large.

III. AWARD OF OAK LEAF CLUSTER - AIR MEDAL. 1. Under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, as amended, a third Oak Leaf Cluster in lieu of a fourth Air Medal is awarded to the following named individual for meritorious achievement while participating in aerial flight:

CHARLES E. MC MURRAY, 0307461, Captain, 36th Infantry Division Artillery, 9 December 1944 to 1 February 1945, France. Entered the Service from Dallas, Texas.
