GALENDAR OF EVENTS:

October 1: Company "A", 656th TD Bn was detached from the Battalion the attached to VI Gerps to guard VI Gerps Command Post. Reconnaissance Company located a German Artillery and small arm assumition dump and its location was reported to VI Serps. Reconstitution movement forward was made.

Lombardi were received and road priority beginning at Odob house for the given. Preparations for movement were made.

October 5: Movement of the Sattalion to an accounty and more function Lombardi was effected and expensions or defined up actalizated in the new area with the mission of appearing the Compactific Stands

October 4: The area of the Corps right flank was recommended during the day and Destroyer positions were improved. A specific finisher rear echelon was selected in Guardia Lembardi and trucks were disputed to bring the rear echelon forward. The Aller echelon closed in the new location shortly after dark.

Cotober 5: Recommissance of the area was continued and eighteen (18) 25 ton eargo trucks were furnished to VI Corps for hauling ammunition and equipment.

October 6: Recommissance work was continued and the Sattali n Commander located a possible area for further displacement forward. No other activity during the day.

Cotober 7: No activity during the morning, but an order for movement to the vicinity of 3. Heorgio was received in the afternoon. A warning order was issued by the Battalion Commander.

October 8: The Battalian moved to a position near 3. Reorgio and closed in the area at about 1000 hours. Reconnaissance of the area was made during the afternoon.

October 9: No activity during the 9th of October. Positions were improved.

and the staff was made and possible assembly areas in the vicinity of onte were checked.

etober 11: To activity on the 11th of Ectober.

entablished and corps rtillery fficer recommended that the ttalion he moved to the vicinity of contembers close support of the former elements could be made.

Ectober 13: In order from Commanding eneral VI Corps to move the Rettalion to vicinity of conte on 14 Retober 43 was received. Recommaissance of the area was made and the Battalion Commander issued much order for movement to start at 2600 hours the next acrains.

Cotober 14: Movement of the Battalion started on the morning of 14 Motober 45 as planned under the command of the Executive Officer. The Battalion Commander attended the presentation of Awards to members of Company "C" at Fifth Army Heed Parters. The presentation was made by Lt General CLARK.

The Battalion closed in its new area near Ponte at 1015 hours. A new location for the rear echelon was selected and plans to move the rear echelon the following day were made.

- October 15: Recommissance of the surrounding area was made and plans for protecting the rear of Corps were completed. The rear eshesion and moved to its new location in Fonts.
- Cotober 16: Recommissance in the Corps area was continued and liaison was maintained with 645th TD 3n and contact made with the 45th Division.
- Gotober 13: Iwo latoons of Jumpany "B" were moved to indirect firing positions in the 45th Division sector. The Ranger Platoon accompanied the "B" Jumpany Platoons. An unexploded aerial bomb was located and taped off near the rear schelon area and a report was made to Jumpanding Beneral, VI Jumpa, In the afternoon an order was received to move the Battalion in an area near Telese. The area was quickly reconnoitered and the Battalion was moved that evening.
- October 18: An Conservation Post was established from which indirect fire missions could be observed. A notice was received that General LUCAS, Commanding Teneral, VI Corps, would present decorations to Staff Tergeant CODE and Staff Tergeant CODE
- on enemy mine field was located by the Reconnaissance Company and the mines were lifted by the lioneer Platoon of that Organization.
- Warning order for the movement to the vicinity of Ruviano was received and a route reconnaissance was made that evening.
- ictober 19: Reconnaissance for an assembly area in the vicinity of luvanio is made and Jeneral LUCA: presented sliver Stars to Staff Sergeant No. 1 and Staff Sergeant No. 1 ARKS at 1100 hours. Parning order was issued to move on the following morning, but later orders from VI Corps directed that the movement should not be made.
- ctober 20: No activity on this into but late in the afternoon clearance was received to move the Sa talion to the vicinity of Ruviano and the order previously prepared was issued.
- and closed in the area at 1045 hours. Recommaissance of the surrounding erea was made and comouflage of the installations was checked.
- and Diaison maintained with the forward units. Buildings for the rear echelon were selected in Ruviano.
- Cotober 25: The rear echelon was moved to Ruviano and Liaison with the Colst Fank Destroyer Battalion was established.
 - ctober 24: To activity other than reconnaissance for this date.
- ctober 25: Nord was received that Johnsony "" would be released from Decirl Dity with VI Jorps and return to Sattalion control. Reconcissance was made of an area in which to associate that Johnsony. "." Johnsony word into the area selected, completing the movement at 1/10 hours.

October 26: We activity other than recommissance.

October 27: Forward areas were reconnoitered for a contemplated movement of the Battalion. Limison was maintained with forward units.

October 28: Additional recommissance was made for an assembly area in the vicinity of Pietramelara. A French Boldier, who had escaped from an enemy Prisoner of War enclosure, was brought to the Command Post and gave some information regarding German troops and gun dispositions. He was sent to VI Corps for further questioning. A request for the transfer of our Communication Officer to Fifth Army was received.

October 29: The second Platoon of Company "J", which was on duty with Fifth Army Hoadquarters, was ordered on Detached Jervice to the Antitank Regiment, British 7th Armored Division at Alvanova to instruct in Tank Destroyer principles, nomenclature of M-10 Tank Destroyer and Motor Carriage M-10 and the 5 inch gun. The Battalion Commander issued a warning order for movement of the Battalion to the vicinity of Riardo.

October 50: The Battalion moved to the vicinity of Riarde, establishing Headquarters just south of Pietramelara. All troops closed in the area by 1500 hours. A mined crossing was reported by an Italian Civilian and the information forwarded to Commanding Seneral, VI Corps.

October 51: Plans were prepared for protecting the rear of the Corps and also for reinforcing either of the forward Tank Destroyer Battalions. Reconnaissance of the forward areas was made.
