I. POSTHUMOUS AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL. Under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-43, as amended, a Bronze Star Medal is posthumously awarded to the following named individual for heroic achievement in combat:

ALFRED EMMETT, JR., Private First Class, Company 4, 1st Infantry Regiment, 14 February 1945, France. Son of Mrs. E. E. Kennedy (Mother), Route 22, Livingston, Tennessee.

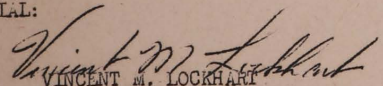
