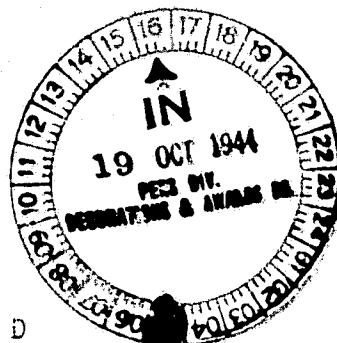

WITHDRAWAL OF GENERAL ORDERS

So much of General Orders 375, Headquarters 86th Infantry Division, dated 7 October 1944, as pertains to the award of the Purple Heart to John Ladyka, 32 000 750, for wounds received in action on 30 September 1944, is withdrawn.

The Purple Heart has been posthumously awarded by the Department of the Army on 28 January 1945 and the above-named individual died on 18 October 1944, as a result of wounds received on 30 September 1944.
