

EAGLE ROOSTS ON CHIEF OF STAFF SHOULDERS
Lt. Col. Clayton P. Kerr of Dallas, Texas, newly assigned Division Chief of Staff, recently received a commission to the rank of full Colonel.

Colonel Kerr commanded a battalion of the 144th Inf. with the mobilization of the Texas National Guard in November, 1940. He was Executive Officer with the 72nd Inf. Brigade and later named Division Inspector General.

With his former commanding officer, Brig. Gen. Preston A. Weatherred, also of Dallas, and now retired, Col. Kerr was co-author of the book, Pointers for Infantry Troop Leaders. Seventy thousand copies are now carried by Infantry Officers and non-commissioned officers wherever American Doughboys are fighting or training.
