SECTION I -- POSTHUMOUS AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL

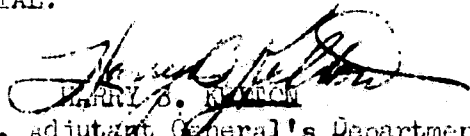
