SECTION I -- CITATION OF UNIT

The 141st Infantry Regiment, for exceptional performance from 26 May to 26 June 1944 in the monumental 29-day push from the Anzio beachhead area through Rome to the hills overlooking Pisa. By a series of brilliant maneuvers the 141st Infantry Regiment broke through the stubborn enemy defenses near Anzio and succeeded in smashing hostile resistance in the key city of Velletri. Carrying out orders implicitly and coordinating movements skillfully, the Regiment reached the outskirts of Rome on 4 June and, on the following day, moved in the triumphal march through the Eternal City. Without relaxing the tightening grip on the demoralized enemy, the drive continued forward despite heavy losses in men and materiel, until the 240 mile advance was concluded on the high ground commanding the approaches to Pisa. The determination and accomplishments of the 141st Infantry Regiment were a vital factor in delivering the most crushing blow suffered by the enemy forces in Italy.
